Sports Physicals

Any student wishing to participate on any school sports team next year will need a sports physical. Summer is a great time to get that taken care of, with less disruption to your school schedule—a blank physical form is included in eligible students' "summer study" packet.

Your own doctor may do your sports physical. St. Clair County Health Department's "Teen Health Center" offers them for approximately \$40 (or on a sliding fee scale, depending on family income); they also accept many insurances. Call first for an appointment: 810.987.1311. The Center is located at 2215 Court Street, Port Huron (enter off 20th Street, behind Port Huron High School between the tennis courts and pool). Check at "Prompt Care" centers or "Minute Clinics"—you may be able to have your physical done inexpensively at such places.
